



Cabin Collins Cocktail

Recipe Description

Featured in Weller's *Let's Have a Patio Luau* advertising booklet from 1961, the Cabin Collins is a bourbon-based take on the Tom Collins. With the fresh juice of lime and lemon, a dash of sugar, and a fizzy finish of club soda, this cocktail evokes mid-century backyard parties and warm weather cheer. Part of the Retro Recipes Revived collection.

Ingredients

- 1 heaping teaspoon of extra fine granulated sugar
- Juice of $\frac{1}{2}$ lime
- Juice of $\frac{1}{2}$ lemon
- Ice cubes
- 1 jigger (1.5 oz) Weller's Cabin Still Bourbon
- Club soda to fill

Directions

1. In a 12 oz. glass, dissolve sugar in the fresh juice of $\frac{1}{2}$ lime and $\frac{1}{2}$ lemon.
2. Add ice cubes.
3. Pour in 1 jigger of Weller's Cabin Still Bourbon.
4. Fill glass with club soda and stir gently.
5. Serve immediately with a straw or citrus garnish, if desired.

Notes

For a sweeter twist, garnish with a cherry or add a splash of pineapple juice for extra patio flair.
